Rutland City Hall, 1 Strongs Avenue, Rutland

A brief UCF Council business meeting will be held in the Board of Alderman Chambers on the 2nd floor of Rutland City Hall. Staff will update Council on our funding situation and our updated strategic plan. Subcommittees should be prepared to report to the group on winter/spring activity (5 min. or less). 10:00 AM Walking Tour of Downtown Rutland

Rutland City Forester and Arborist Tim Smith, Rutland City Assistant Forester and Arborist Joseph Epler, and Rutland City Engineer Ted Gillen will guide us on a downtown walking tour. We will visit several sites that will be dramatically altered soon with the infusion of two large grants to remove concrete and install suspended pavement systems (Silva Cells) and street trees. We'll also see trees planted over the years from the city's tree nursery, public art and murals, and Tim and Joe will demonstrate injection of systemic insecticide on one of the ~120 public ash trees treated biannually.

12:00 PM Lunch Downtown, on your own

Tim and Joe will provide recommendations for lunch at one of the many local restaurants and we'll reconvene at Pine Hill Park.

1:00 PM Pine Hill Park Tour

Shelley Lutz, volunteer with the Pine Hill Partnership (<u>read about Shelley here!</u>) will meet us at <u>Pine Hill Park</u> on the outskirts of the city. The park is managed by volunteers and the City cooperatively and there has been great focus here on creating more recreational opportunities in Rutland. The Pine Hill Partnership is working to both increase sustainability of the trail system and expand access to the benefits of public green space.
